Dear Downtown Merchant,

The 2013 Red Poppy Festival will be held Saturday and Sunday, April 27th and 28th on the downtown square. Just a reminder, any booth or table that is setup during the Red Poppy Festival must have paid a vendor fee and been approved by the festival committee to avoid duplications. No additional booths will be permitted on downtown sidewalks during this festival weekend. If you plan to set up a table on the sidewalk in front of your store, please be sure it is your store's merchandise only. Thank you for your cooperation as we want the best for our downtown merchants and our paid vendors.

The following streets will close at 7:00 a.m. Friday, April 26 –6:00 pm Friday, April 26

- Austin Avenue between 7th Street and 9th Street
- 6th Street and 7th Street between Austin Ave. and Church Street
- 8th Street between Rock Street and Church Street
- Main Street between 5th Street and 9th Street

The following streets will close at 6:00 pm Friday, April 26 – 6:00 am Saturday, April 27

- 6th, 7th and 8th Streets between Rock Street and Church Street
- Austin Avenue between 5th Street and 9th Street
- Main Street between 5th Street and 9th Street

Please see the enclosed map for the parade route and parade street closure information. Parade street closures will be from 6:00 am Saturday, April 26 through approximately 12:00 noon Saturday, April 26.

The following streets will close at approximately 12:00 noon Saturday, April 28 through approximately 11:00 pm Sunday, April 28

- 5th Street between Austin Avenue and Main Street
- 6th Street between Austin Avenue and Church Street
- 7th and 8th Streets between Rock Street and Church Street
- 9th Street between Austin Avenue and Church Street
- Austin Avenue between 6th Street and 9th Street
- Main Street between 5th Street and 10th Street

No-parking signs will be placed (*as needed*) along the north side of the numbered streets and the west side of the named streets between Martin Luther King Street and College Street and between 2nd Street and University Avenue.
